ABOUT THE CONSULTING PROGRAM

- The Pathways Team includes a School Psychologist, Licensed Board Certified Behavior Analysts, Licensed Board Certified Associate Behavior Analysts, Behavior Specialists, Registered Behavior Technicians, and Consulting Behavior Technicians certified in crisis management available to consult/collaborate short term or ongoing with your district, school, program, classrooms, individual students, and/or families.
- Consultations are available to provide professional development trainings, Registered Behavior
 Technician Training, individual staff trainings, conduct assessments, create treatment programs, manage crisis situations, assist with treatment implementation, provide staffing support to classrooms or individual students, assist students to less restrictive settings, supervise students enrolled in BACB coursework and supervise Registered Behavior Technicians.



- Consultations Services take place across all of Southern New England and works with teams serving students any age in a range of placements, from regular education to self-contained special education programs.
- Assessments include: Functional Behavior
 Assessments, Functional Analyses, Educational
 Assessments, Psychological Assessments, Adaptive
 Behavior Assessments, and Curriculum Based
 Assessments.
- Intervention plans are individualized, evidence based and developed in collaboration with our professional staff and the public school professionals and/or families. The goal of intervention plans is to reduce challenging behavior, improve student progress and increase student independence.

ABA: APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS

 Applied behavior analysis (ABA) is a discipline concerned with the application of behavioral science in real-world settings such as clinics, schools, and industry with the aim of improving socially important issues such as behavior problems and learning (Baer, Wolf, & Risley, 1968).
